

TERMS OF USE FOR THE HUNGARORING CIRCUIT

CAR OPEN DAYS

MOTORSPORT IS DANGEROUS!

GENERAL PROVISIONS

These Terms of Use (hereinafter: **“Terms of Use”**) shall be applied to the Hungaroring Circuit located at 2146 Mogyoród, Hungaroring út 10, and all of its related facilities located at this specified address (hereinafter collectively referred to as **the “Circuit”**) issued by HUNGARORING Sport Zrt. (seat: 2146 Mogyoród, Hungaroring út 10., tax number: 10603226-2-44, company registration number: 13-10-040464, represented by: Zsolt István Gyulay, Chairman and CEO; hereinafter: **“HUNGARORING”**) in connection with the organization of the **car open days** (hereinafter: **“Event”**) to be held at the 4,381-meter-long continuous asphalt strip (hereinafter: **“Track”**) located within the Circuit.

The personal scope of these Terms of Use extends to all persons driving a motor vehicle at the Event (hereinafter: **“Driver”**) and to persons participating as passengers in the motor vehicle (hereinafter: **“Passenger”**). For the purposes of these Terms of Use, the Driver and Passenger are collectively referred to as **“Participant.”**

These Terms of Use are binding on all Participants from the date of issuance and must be complied with. HUNGARORING reserves the right to amend the content of these Terms of Use.

ARRIVAL

Participants may arrive no earlier than 1 (one) hour before the scheduled time of entry onto the first Track section. Participants are advised that those arriving before the aforementioned time will not be permitted to enter the Circuit premises. Please stop in the parking lot in front of the Circuit before entering, in such a way that you do not obstruct free access to and from the Circuit.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION

The technical inspection of vehicles wishing to participate in the Event will take place in a cordoned-off area within the Paddock building located close to the finish line of the Track. Only the specialist conducting the vehicle inspection, his assistant, and the car owner may be present together within this closed area established for inspection purposes.

REGISTRATION

Drivers participating in the Event can register at the designated office by going up the stairs at the end of the Paddock building towards the Pit Entrance, provided their vehicle has passed technical inspection. At this designated office they will also receive answers to any questions that may arise throughout the day. Passenger registration also takes place at the location specified herein.

PIT RENTAL

At the Event venue, Participants have the option to rent a pit for a gross fee of 40,000 HUF, i.e., forty thousand Hungarian Forints. Please note that only simple maintenance tasks, such as tire changes, may be performed in the rented pit areas; activities involving the spillage or leakage of hazardous materials (including, but not limited to, oil changes) are strictly prohibited. The pit Lessee is obligated to remove any waste generated during the rental period and ensure its proper management. By paying the rental fee, the Lessee acknowledges and accepts the rental and usage conditions:

- The Lessee agrees to leave or return the rented pit area in its original condition. If there is a difference between the condition prior to the rental period and the condition after the rental period has expired, the Lessee agrees to reimburse HUNGARORING for the costs of restoring the pit to its original condition, provided that HUNGARORING invoices the Lessee for the costs incurred in connection with the restoration.
- HUNGARORING hereby notifies the Lessee that it is expressly PROHIBITED to affix anything to the walls of the Paddock building or the pit walls.
- HUNGARORING assumes no liability whatsoever for the Lessee’s tools, equipment, or materials brought into the pit area.
- HUNGARORING assumes no liability for any damage or injury, or for any damage to property, arising from the Lessee’s use of the pit.
- Upon becoming aware of any damage occurring during the term of the pit rental, the Lessee shall immediately notify HUNGARORING, and the parties shall draw up a report on the circumstances of the damage.
- HUNGARORING and its agents are entitled to inspect the use of the pit at any time following prior notice and to enter the pit for this purpose.

PROCEDURE

Participants may enter the Track in accordance with the schedule and group allocation announced in advance on the HUNGARORING website. HUNGARORING reserves the right to amend the schedule!

Everyone can use the Track exclusively at their own risk.

Only persons registered as participants may enter the Track. This means that both the Driver and the Passenger are required

to carefully read the declaration of responsibility in advance, review, understand and acknowledge its contents, and then personally complete and sign the declaration in all required places before entering the Track. Failure to do so will result in a PROHIBITION on entering the Track and immediate DISQUALIFICATION from the Event.
During registration, which constitutes a condition of participation in the Event, Drivers must present their reservation confirmation, driver's license, and the vehicle's registration certificate, after which they will receive a sticker authorizing them to drive onto the Track, which must be affixed to the windshield of the vehicle participating in the Event and that has passed technical inspection.
During registration, which is a condition for Passengers' participation in the Event, Passengers must complete the declaration of responsibility applicable to them.
Upon accreditation for the Event, Drivers will be divided into the following groups based on the engine capacity and equipment: I. Category: Under 150 hp (110 kW) II. Category: Over 150 hp (110 kW) and sports
Racing cars with a technical specification book issued by the FIA, the Hungarian National Automobile Sports Federation (MNASZ), or any other ASN, or custom-built racing cars, are not permitted to participate in the Event!
No person under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or other mind-altering substances may enter the Track, either as a Driver or a Passenger.
Participants may enter the pit lane through the designated pit lane entrance upon instruction from the staff coordinating the Event, then, at the start of their group's program, proceed independently onto the Track via the pit exit, and approximately 20 minutes later, they will be flagged off from the marshal post at the finish line. After being flagged off, they must complete a full cool-down lap and drive into the pit lane. Once a group has completed its program, it must leave the pit lane through the gate at the end of the new Paddock building, as instructed by the marshals, and park in the depot behind the Paddock building until the Participant's next program begins.
Participants must leave the Circuit no later than half an hour after the end of the Event.
During the Event, the Passenger is specifically required to comply with the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • remain seated in the vehicle at all times, keep the seatbelt fastened at all times, and keep the windows rolled up; • it is strictly prohibited to exit the vehicle on the Track or service roads, unless expressly instructed to do so by the coordinating staff/emergency personnel, or if an accident or changes in the vehicle's technical condition require immediate evacuation to avoid danger to life or to preserve physical safety; • it is prohibited to disturb or obstruct the driver, or distract the driver's attention from driving (in particular: shouting, sudden movements, talking on the phone, using a flash, taking selfies while driving); • it is prohibited to touch the vehicle's controls (in particular: steering wheel, handbrake, gearshift, pedals, dashboard controls), and to interfere with driving in any way; in accordance with the fact that they are participating in the Event solely as a passenger; • keeps their body parts and belongings inside the vehicle; does not stick their arms or head out, nor hold any objects outside; • any loose objects (e.g., glass, hard objects, cameras/camera cases) in the vehicle's passenger compartment must be secured; otherwise, the coordinating staff may refuse participation; • they may not enter the area located within the primary safety zone of the Track (including run-off areas) without permission; • they may not remain within 1 meter of the Track's safety barriers (cordon tape, debris-catching fence, rubber wall); • any person who fails to comply with the instructions of the coordinating staff or the regulations governing the Event will have their participation in the Event suspended with immediate effect and will be removed from the Circuit area by security personnel.
TECHNICAL CONDITION OF VEHICLES
Only vehicles in perfect technical condition may enter the Track, for which the Driver bears exclusive and full responsibility.
The term "perfect technical condition" of the vehicle includes, among other things: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tires in perfect condition. • Brake system in perfect working order. • An exhaust system in accordance with the Circuit's current noise and sound regulations (maximum limit of 105 dB measured at the vehicle's exhaust tip). <p>The vehicle must comply with the provisions of KöHÉM Decree 5/1990 (IV. 12.) on the technical inspection of road vehicles, which is confirmed by the vehicle's valid registration certificate.</p>
The vehicle must be equipped with a tow hook securely fitted on the front of the vehicle, or the Driver must present the tow hook for inspection before entering the Track. In the absence of a tow hook, the vehicle may not enter the Track.
The general technical condition must ensure operability and operational safety. In order to protect the life and physical safety of Event Participants and staff, as well as to safeguard the Track and the Circuit facilities, HUNGARORING reserves the right to exclude vehicles in a technically objectionable condition from the Circuit.
All Participants must comply with HUNGARORING's regulations, as well as the instructions of the coordinating staff and race marshals involved in the conduct of the Event under all circumstances.
Failure to comply with the flag signals (see below), disregarding the instructions of the marshals, the coordinating staff involved in the conduct of the Event, and HUNGARORING, or intentional collisions or vandalism will result in immediate exclusion from

the Event and the Circuit, and in some cases, a claim for damages.

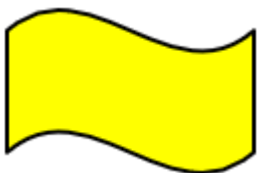
The Participant acknowledges that they are liable for any damage caused by themselves or their vehicle on the Track, throughout the entire Circuit area, or within its facilities.

SAFETY REGULATIONS

For your own safety and that of others, please take the following basic safety principles and measures:

- Seat belts must be fastened at all times. Windows must be fully rolled up, or the vehicle's windows must be covered with a protective net. The steering wheel must be held with both hands while driving. Driving sideways or drifting is prohibited!
- Traffic on the Track is one-way, moving clockwise. The full width of the track may be used for driving, and overtaking is allowed from both sides.
- The Track is used by multiple drivers at the same time. The Track is not intended for racing or training, but for free driving; therefore, drivers must pay extra attention to slower vehicles.
- Avoid unpredictable lane changes, zigzagging, and cutting in during braking distance.
- Stopping on the Track is prohibited! If you cannot reach the pit lane, you must try to leave the Track with your vehicle at a barrier opening (marked with orange paint on the barrier). If this is not possible, you must stop the car as far away from the Track as possible and wait for technical assistance after jumping over the barrier.
- If you need to leave your vehicle, never turn your back on oncoming traffic; always keep an eye on approaching cars!
- The maximum speed limit in the pit lane is 60 km/h. You may only drive in the direction of travel.
- Parking is prohibited in the inner, so-called fast lane of the pit lane.
- Only enter the Track when the pit exit light is green or flashing blue.
- When driving out of the pit lane, do not under any circumstances disturb those already on the Track! When entering the Track, it is prohibited to cross the white pit exit line (the line running parallel to the direction of travel on the main straight between the pit exit and Turn 1)!
- It is prohibited to use the run-off areas to gain an advantage, to overtake, or to cut corners. If you are forced to leave the Track, return carefully and with due caution.
- The rules of public transport do not govern the assessment of possible accidents that may occur on the Track. Collisions are generally considered normal racing incidents. We recommend obtaining additional insurance coverage.

All participants must be familiar with the following flag signals and must act in accordance with their instructions for their own safety and that of others:



YELLOW FLAG:

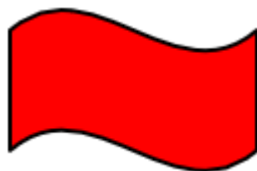
DANGER, NO OVERTAKING

Slow down and be prepared to stop! Do not overtake until the green flag is shown.



GREEN FLAG:

THE TRACK IS CLEAR OF ALL DANGERS



RED FLAG, RED LIGHT:

EVENT SUSPENDED

Slow down, return to the pit lane after completing the lap!



RED-AND-YELLOW STRIPPED FLAG:

GRIP CONDITIONS HAVE CHANGED

Drive carefully; the track surface may be slippery (oil, dust, etc.)



BLACK-AND-WHITE CHECKERED FLAG:

THE SESSION IS OVER

The session is over; upon completing the lap, exit the track through the pit entrance!

Event Participants must fully comply with the Circuit Rules (general visitor terms and conditions) at all times while on the Circuit¹

Any person who fails to comply with the instructions of the Event staff or the rules governing the conduct of the Event will have their participation in the Event suspended immediately and will be removed from the Circuit premises by security personnel.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation! We wish you safe driving and a pleasant time!

DATA PROCESSING - DATA PROTECTION

Please read carefully!

Event Participants acknowledge that the operator of the Hungaroring Circuit, i.e. the HUNGARORING Sport Zrt. (Seat: 2146 Mogyoród, Hungaroring út 10.; Company Registration No.: 13-10-040464; Tax No.: 10603226-2-44), with respect to its legitimate interests, shall be entitled to record, store and process their personal data voluntarily provided in the statement of responsibility signed by the Participants in accordance with the data protection legislation and international recommendations, the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679/EU (GDPR), in compliance with the provisions of Act CXII of 2011 on the Right to Informational Self-Determination and Freedom of Information (Info tv.), and in accordance with the privacy policy. Information regarding data processing in connection with the declaration of responsibility is available at <https://hungaroring.hu/site/hu/informacio/dokumentumok>. By participating in the Event, the Participants hereby declares that they have read and understood the contents of this notice in advance and have accepted its terms.

Event Participants acknowledge that images, audio, and video recordings made of them may constitute personal data, and that their processing may serve communication, promotional, and marketing purposes related to the Event. Event Participants acknowledge that, based on their consent, the recordings may be transferred to HUNGARORING Sport Zrt. and they agents (in particular agencies, subcontractors, and media partners) for the purposes described above, solely to the extent necessary to achieve the specified objectives.

Event Participants acknowledge that they have the right to request further information from the Company regarding the processing of their data by emailing gdpr@hungaroring.hu, and (they may modify or withdraw their consent to the processing of their email address as personal data at any time in writing to the data controller without providing a reason) they may request the correction, restriction, blocking, or deletion of my data. Event Participants have the right to object, to object to direct marketing, to prevent automated decision-making and profiling, as well as the right to data portability and judicial redress, and they may initiate proceedings with the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information. HUNGARORING Sport Zrt. treats Event Participants personal data confidentially and does not disclose it to third parties.

PHOTO AND AUDIO RECORDING + PUBLICATION/USE PERMISSION - Please read carefully!

Event Participants acknowledge and expressly consent to the taking of image, audio, and video recordings at the Circuit (including, among other things, recordings from fixed cameras, handheld cameras, cameras fixed on vehicles, and drone footage), in which they—as a user of the Circuit—may appear, and they will not make any claims against HUNGARORING Sport Zrt., the creators of the recordings, or their authorized users in connection with this (the creation and use of the recordings). The privacy notice regarding the related data processing is available at <https://hungaroring.hu/site/hu/informacio/dokumentumok>. By participating in the Event, the Participants hereby declares that they have read and understood the contents of this notice in advance and have accepted its terms.

With regard to the recordings, Event Participants grant HUNGARORING Sport Zrt. (as well as its agents, collaborators, and agencies) a **free, non-exclusive, territorially unlimited (worldwide), and time-unlimited** license to use the recordings of them in **any known or future** manner of use, in particular for recording, editing/cutting, reproduction, public communication, broadcasting, online publication, social media, PR, promotion, advertising, and communication related to the Event.

Event Participants acknowledge that the recordings **may be edited, trimmed**, or combined with other materials, and that they may be used with the involvement of third parties (in particular agencies, subcontractors, or media partners); they declare that **they will not assert any claims for fees, damages, or other compensation** in connection with the creation and use of the recordings, and they will not make any claims against HUNGARORING Sport Zrt. or those authorized to use the recordings. Event Participants acknowledge that the withdrawal of their consent **does not affect** the legality of recordings made prior to the withdrawal and uses already made.
